Job Scope	<p>The Subject Coordinator at SISD is expected to ensure high quality education for all students in their specialist area and to improve the quality of learning and standards of achievement.</p> <p>The Arts and Design Coordinator plays a key role in the whole-school implementation and organization of Art, Design, Drama and Music in close collaboration with the Head of Secondary and the MYP/DP/CP coordinators. He/She is responsible for the facilitation of design and arts teaching that is collaboratively planned, communicated, taught and assessed. He/She is responsible for the quality and organization of portfolio-based assessment for external IB moderation</p> <p>The duties outlined in this job description are in addition to those covered as Secondary Years Subject Teacher.</p>		

Main Duties and Responsibilities

This not an exhaustive list and all duties/responsibilities:

- Promote and inspire high quality unit planning, collaboration and vertical alignment across visual art, music, drama and design subjects.
- Leads participation in the Building Quality Curriculum review cycles.
- Leads the alignment of the curriculum and unit planners with the Swiss Canton Wallis standards.
- Ensure students are well prepared for the MYP ePortfolio tasks and DP group 3 courses
- Lead standardisation of assessment for MYP to ensure correct application of assessment criteria twice per year
- Advise on issues related to progression between MYP and DP/CP, subject pathways in BTEC and DP group 6 subjects and the opening of future courses
- Report on Assessment Point data related to student progress and attainment for MYP and DP group 6 Arts courses and MYP Design at regular intervals
- Ensure completion of unit reflections, review and Managebac assessment gradebooks on transition between units of instruction across the subject on a bi-monthly basis
- Ensure there is a portfolio-based approach with process journals development across all years of the MYP
- Collate resource requests, assist in distribution of resources and advise on future acquisitions in semester 2
- Promote interdisciplinary connections and preparation for the grade 10 interdisciplinary through participation in interdisciplinary units for other grades
- Liaise with the programme coordinators to advise on measures to enhance curriculum adaption and development of learning skills
- Contributes to the Emitterisation of student displays and creation of connections to local culture through the art and design subjects
- Supports the development of exhibits and performances in the arts in the life of Secondary school

In liaison with the Head of Secondary:

- Take responsibility for student attainment and progress in arts, design, drama and music subjects, account for gaps and advise on measures for additions to the school improvement plan
- Observe the quality of lessons in arts, design, drama and music as part of the appraisal process and report on strengths and areas to improve
- Line Manage teachers in the Arts & Design dept.

Teaching:

- Design, prepare and deliver a high-quality curriculum for grades within the IB MYP/DP framework to suit the individual needs of all students
- Nurture meaningful relationships with students and provide the individual attention they need
- Inspire mixed culture and ability classes, by creating challenging yet inclusive and engaging learning opportunities for all students
- Maintain constant awareness of the needs of any students to whom English is additional language
- Maintain a safe learning environment for students
- Assess and monitor student progress and provide targets so that all learners can see success and improve incessantly
- Liaise with the Head of Secondary School and curriculum coordinators to ensure effective delivery of the curriculum to specified classes, including selecting resources and managing them efficiently in the classroom
- Adhere to the expectations as set out in the SISD Teacher Standards Document
- Assume responsibility for the pastoral care of a class of students, paying particular attention to personal development and child protection
- Collaborate with other secondary teachers and curriculum coordinators to deliver an interdisciplinary curriculum and share new ideas, approaches and professional knowledge
- Communicate accurately and regularly with parents
- Participate in school activities outside regular school hours to include, but not limited to, ASA's, Boarding House(s) support, school trips, staff meetings, parent's evenings, open days, INSET days, professional development training sessions, conferences and workshops, induction and if applicable examination supervision
